

# WOODBIDGE VALLEY POOL ADMISSION RULES

## IDENTIFICATION CARDS

For admission to the pool, all members need to have an up to date, pool-issued ID card, and it must be presented **each** time you visit. If you do not have your ID card with you, you may be allowed to enter if you can provide other positive proof of your identification, but you must bring your card the next time. Please do not argue with the guards. They are just doing their jobs.

## MEMBERSHIP STATUS

You must be current on the annual dues payment and any other fees owed before you can be admitted. Payment can be made at the front desk. Please write your bond number on your check.

Please bear with us as we verify the status of members listed on your bond. Remember, only permanent members of your household can be included. **Proof of residency may be required.** Any additions to your membership must be approved, in writing, by the Board of Directors.

Babysitters may be issued a temporary ID card for use only when they are supervising your children, if approved by the Board.

## GUESTS

Your yearly guest passes (5) can be signed for and received at the front desk.

Guest fees are \$5 per person *at all times*.

Children under 1 year old and **non-swimming** grandparents are free. All other guests, even non-swimmers, must either pay a guest fee or use a guest pass.

For houseguests, a pass for 1 week (7 consecutive days) costing \$15 can be obtained from the manager (1 week only). If you have a summer houseguest, you may purchase a season pass for \$75 each person, with the permission of the Board of Directors.

- \* You must be at least 13 years old to bring in a guest (or be accompanied by an adult).
- \* Guests 12 and under must pass the deep well test to swim in the deep well or go off the diving board.
- \* Your guests must leave when you do.
- \* Guest fees are not refundable.
- \* 10 or more guests (per bond) are considered a party and must be booked 2 weeks in advance. Party reservation forms available from the manager.
